

DESIGN, ERECTION AND VERIFICATION

CITY & GUILDS 2391 – 20 (Level 3)

This short course was developed to meet one of the various requirements for NICEIC Qualifying Supervisor status.

The course is 24 hours duration in which time the candidate will need to:

1. Undertake a three hour written assessment set by the City & Guilds.
(10 Questions)
2. Complete a City & Guilds project which demonstrates the ability to design and consider erection methods for a typical installation.
3. Complete a practical assessment

Success in all three components results in a full C&G Design, Erection & Verification certificate (ex 2400) whereas success in any one, only attracts a Record of Achievement for that component.

Courses will run subject to demand, and will be delivered one evening a week for 10 or 12 weeks.

It is not considered wise to undertake this course unless candidates have considerable knowledge of the Electrical Contracting Industry, and have attained C&G 17th Edition and Inspection, Testing and Certification qualifications. However consideration, advice and guidance will be given to all interested applicants.

Candidates will be required to have their own copies of the 17th Edition (BS7671:2008) and the Guidance note 3 on Inspection and Testing.
