This short course was originally developed to enable JIB registered electricians to become aware of the requirements of the then, 15th. Edition. Since that time, candidates other than JIB operatives have attended such courses, and it has now become a valuable qualification for all in the electrical industry and allied trades and professions. We consider this qualification a necessary entry requirement to the C&G 2400, Design, Erection and Verification course.

The programme is of 24 hours duration, in which time the candidate will study all aspects of the Regulations including basic design procedures and the fundamentals of testing & inspection. The final City & Guilds assessment is a two hour multiple choice computerised on-line examination comprising 60 questions.

Courses will run subject to demand, and will be delivered one evening a week for 10 or 12 weeks, or one day a week for four weeks.

Course handouts will be provided, but candidates will be required to have their own copies of the latest editions of the 16th. Edition (BS7671), and the On Site-Guide, (all of which can be obtained from any major bookstore or direct from our web site).
