

# **DESIGN, ERECTION AND VERIFICATION**

Of

## **ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS**

### **CITY & GUILDS 2391 - 02 (Formerly 2400)**

This short course was developed to meet one of the various requirements for NICEIC Qualifying Supervisor status.

The course is 24 hours duration in which time the candidate will need to:

Undertake a three hour written assessment set by the City & Guilds, (2391-201, 10 Questions)

Complete a City & Guilds project which demonstrates the ability to design and consider erection methods for a typical installation, (2391-202).

Have evidence of success in the area of testing and inspection (Part of the C&G 2391-01 Inspection, Testing & Certification course), (2391-102)

Success in all three components results in a full C&G Design, Erection & Verification certificate (ex 2400) whereas success in any one, attracts a Record of Achievement for that component.

Courses will run subject to demand, and will be delivered one evening a week for 10 or 12 weeks.

It is not considered wise to undertake this course unless candidates have considerable knowledge of the Electrical Contracting Industry, and have attended a recent C&G 2381 16<sup>th</sup> Edition course and a C&G 2391 Inspection, Testing and Certification course. However consideration, advice and guidance will be given to all interested applicants.

Candidates will be required to have their own copies of the latest editions of the 16<sup>th</sup> Edition (BS7671), the On-Site-Guide and the Guidance note 3 on Inspection and Testing. (all of which can be obtained from any major bookstore or direct from our web site).
